HEF is committed to supporting the next generation of hospitality leaders by offering scholarships, career exploration opportunities, and hands-on learning programs, including support for ProStart, culinary students, hospitality majors, and current industry professionals seeking to advance their career.

Purpose of the Scholarship

The Hospitality Educational Foundation provides financial assistance to qualified students and working professionals pursuing higher education or approved advanced training programs in culinary arts, hospitality management, restaurant management, tourism, lodging, and related fields. Award recipients must demonstrate a strong intention to use their education and skills within Nebraska's hospitality industry.

Scholarship Determination

Scholarships are awarded by a Scholarship Selection Committee, made up of HEF and the Omaha Restaurant Association committee members.

Scholarship selections are based solely on published criteria, including commitment to hospitality career pathways, academic effort, financial need, and alignment with the mission of HEF. Scholarship amounts may vary based on available funding and applicant qualifications.

Interviews

Selected finalists will be invited to participate in a Zoom interview with industry professionals and members of the scholarship committee.

- ProStart students or high school seniors continuing their education entering culinary, hospitality, or tourism programs
- College students currently enrolled in hospitality-related majors
- Current hospitality professionals seeking career advancement, certifications, or additional training

Award Disbursement

Scholarship funds are paid directly to accredited institutions or approved training programs and cannot be issued directly to the student.
